But we had to repair a lot of things, to connect a bigger watertank, to make a water connection to the kitchen etc. When we took our furnitures from Eldoret we saw that most of them got broken. Therefore we called a carpenter to come and to repair all the cupboards, tables, chairs... After that I could start to unpack.

Because of all those repairs our movement took much longer than we have thought. While I was unpacking and tidying up Robert was building a place for our tree rabbits and five chicken. Also he was building a fence that our dogs are not able anymore to run away. Now they really enjoy to play and run through the whole garden.

On the 22nd of February we went together with Joseph for a youth rally to Mogotio. On the 6th of March we went together to Olgoligei where Robert was living for six weeks while I was in Germany. We went to three Primary Schools and one Secondary Schools to show the Jesus Movie to the children and teenagers and to give them Gideon Bibles.

On the 9th of March there was a Sundayschool teacher training at Nakuru. More than 100 teachers were attending this training. On the 14th of March there was a children rally for all the Scripture Union Bible Club children at Nakuru. Almost 1000 children were coming from 23 schools. They were presenting songs, reportages, dramas and songs. The motto was the story of „Esther“. It was very nice!!!

Then I became sick. During the unpacking most likely I was blocking a nerve inside of my left thigh because I can not feel anything anymore inside that thigh (till today). I went to the doctor and he forgot that I have a chronically gastritis. He gave me medicine for anti-rheumatics and pain killer. Instead of helping those medicine was causing a bleeding inside my stomach. For more than one week I had a black stool and till now a lot of diarrhoea. Meanwhile I am feeling much better. The bleeding has stopped. The colour of the stool is now normal again. But because of the diarrhoea I lost a lot of water and till now I am completely weak. Please pray that God will touch and heal me and that he may give me new power that I will be able to start to work proper with Scripture Union Kenya.

On the 23rd of March Robert became 30 years. I prayed and asked God for special power for that day and he answered my prayers. We went by car to Kapkuikui to celebrate Robert's birthday with all the teachers and pupils of Kapkuikui Primary School. The teachers and children were very happy to see us...
