Robert started a new dancing group at our church and already on the second meeting more than 15 children were coming. Also he is assisting the church choir on Sunday after the service.

Two weeks ago Robert's Bible School opened. They have trimesters. This semester Robert has six subjects: History of Mission & Theology of Mission, Eschatology & Ecclesiology, Writings of Johannes, Pastoral Theology, Jeremiah- Exegesis and Modern Church History. The Bible School Teaching is on a high level. Therefore every evening I am assisting Robert to read his scripts and to learn for the next day. The Bible school offers only morning classes.

As an entrance requirement for the Bible School Robert will need the Kenyan Secondary Examination which he doesn't have for now. We found out that first he will have to do the Kenyan Primary Examination in 2016, before he can do the Secondary Examination in 2017. Therefore on every afternoon and on Saturday mornings Robert is attending a School for Adults to prepare for those examinations.

Please pray for Robert. Because it is not easy for him, to get up so early every morning and to learn the whole day. He prefers to work practical things... Therefore he may need our prayers that he will not give up and continues, even when it is not easy...
